What does a school meal consist of?

#### **Breakfast**

The following must be offered every day:

1 serving of juice or fruit
1 serving of milk

AND

2 servings of bread/grains (i.e. cereal & toast)

\*\*Students must select 3 out of the 4 food items to be considered a full breakfast. One of the 3 selected, must be a fruit or juice. Students would not be able to have both a piece of fruit and a juice.

#### Lunch

The following will be offered every day:

1 serving of meat/meat alternative
1 serving of milk
1 serving of bread/grain
2 servings of vegetables/fruits

\*\*Students must select 3 out of the 5 choices to be considered a full lunch. One of the 3 items selected must be a fruit or vegetable.

#### <u>Snacks</u>

In addition to meals students can purchase Smart Snack approved drinks and snacks. If you would like to put a limit on what extra items your child can buy please contact their cafeteria manager.

### \* How can I pay for my child's meals?

#### **Options**

- 1. Cash given to the cashier
- 2. Personal checks given to the cashier
- 3. Credit card payments made through www.k12paymentcenter.com
- \* K12 Payment Center?

K12 Payment Center is an online service that allows you to make payments to your child's account online via credit/debit card

Each transaction will have a \$1.95 processing fee. Parents will be able to make payments to multiple lunch accounts at the same time, eliminating dual transactions (and dual transaction fees). You can also view your child's meal history and sign up for low balance notifications via email.
