Food Sales

Board Policy: A-15 Adopted: August 10, 1992

I. General Policy Statement

The Board recognizes that the Child Nutrition Program is a vital part of he total school program. This policy describes the standards by which the Child Nutrition Program shall be operated.

II. Child Nutrition Program Regulations

- A. All food and beverage sales before or during the established lunch period shall be conducted through the Child Nutrition Program.
- B. The Child Nutrition Program shall retain all receipts from the sale of food and or beverage items which come iunder it's program.
- C. All school food service income shall be used for the purpose of operating the school system's non-profit Child Nutrition Program.

III. Sale of Extra Food Items Regulations

- A. Extra food items include but are not restricted to soft drinks, packaged snacks, donuts, juice, popcorn, and homemade deserts.
- B. Any sale of extra food items in the lunchroom or its general area must be on a non-profit basis. "Non-profit basis" means that any income shall be used to support the Child Nutrition Program.
- C. Schools may sell extra food items on a profit basis after the beginning of the period following the end of the last lunch period. These sales shall not take place in or near the school lunchroom.

IV. Program Funding

Child Nutrition Program Funds may be reclaimed or withheld from schools which violate program regulations.
