

## Cameras On Buses

Board Policy: A-28  
Adopted: June 10, 1996  
Revised: March 9, 2009

### I. General Policy Statement

The Haywood County Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing safe transportation for students and approves the use of cameras on school and activity buses. These recordings may be used as supportive information when a student violates Board Policy SA-1 (Student Conduct and Discipline).

### II. Regulations and Procedures

#### A. Notification:

Parents will be informed that cameras will be used on school and activity buses. Such notification will be provided through the distribution of Board Policy SA-1 (Student Conduct And Discipline). All buses will have cameras permanently mounted in them. Decals will alert students that the bus is equipped with a camera.

#### B. Storage and Use of Recordings:

Recordings are digital and may be saved by administrators for disciplinary purposes.

#### C. Disciplinary Process:

The principal or designee may use the recordings as supportive evidence on student misconduct on a bus according to Board Policy SA-1 (Student Conduct and Discipline).
