Responsibilities for Food Allergy Management in Haywood County Schools

Parents

- Provide school with medical documentation of a life-threatening food allergy
- Complete forms required for treatment/medication for the food allergy at school with a written statement/signature from the students health care provider/physician
- Provide school with approved emergency medication for the allergy
- Keep school informed of changes in student's condition
- Request/decline a Health Care Plan for Food Allergy
- Meet with staff to develop individualized Health Care Plan for student if requested.

Principal

- · Meet with parents of student with life threatening food allergy if needed
- Inform school nurse/staff of student with food allergy if needed
- Assign school staff to part of team to develop individualized Health Care plan if requested by parent.

School Nurse

- Inform principal and school staff of student's allergy after processing Health History Update forms or receiving information from parents
- Provide required forms to parents for medical documentation. (Prescription Medication Permission, Allergy Management, Permission to Carry, Diet Orders, request for Food Allergy Plan, and Declination of Food Allergy Plan Forms)
- Assess and disseminate completed forms to appropriate staff. Example-completed diet order to cafeteria manager, etc
- Develop and disseminate Emergency Action Plans to school staff/cafeteria (when parents have provided school with completed documentation and medication for treatment of allergy)
- Offer Request for Food Allergy Health Care plan to parents with additional concerns
- Offer Declination form to parents who do not want a Food Allergy Health Care plan
- Train/update staff in the treatment of anaphylaxis
- Meet with staff to develop requested Food Allergy Health Care Plan
- Provide staff/parents with copies of above plan

Teachers/staff

- Complete training in the treatment and prevention of anaphylaxis.
- Keep Emergency Action Plan and needed medication if student does not carry in a safe, accessible place
- Inform school nurse of changes, concerns
- Supervise students with food allergies while in cafeteria, in class, and on field trips
- Administer epinephrine by auto-injector if needed.

Cafeteria

- Meet with school nurse concerning students with life-threatening food allergies
- Give students with food allergies diet orders and keep on file
- Document students with food allergies in cafeteria component of power school
- Keep foods with identified allergens separate from other foods/ include utensils, supplies that come in contact with allergens
- Clean tables to prevent cross contact exposure to allergens
- Identify foods that contain known allergens or foods processed in facilities that process nuts and provide information to students, staff, and parents.
