Haywood County Schools is excited to provide Summer School for students who do not earn a proficient score on the North Carolina End-of-Grade Tests. Summer School will provide students who do not demonstrate proficiency on the tests the opportunity to receive additional instruction and have a second chance to receive a passing score on the state tests. Students who do not demonstrate proficiency on EOG tests may not be eligible for promotion.

Bethel Elementary's Summer School program will be in session Monday, June 15 through Friday, June 26. Summer School hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Students must attend Summer School a minimum of six days to be eligible for retesting.

Students will report directly to their summer school classroom and must be picked up promptly at 12:00 p.m. Snacks will be provided each day of Summer School. Your child's teacher will contact you upon receiving scores to discuss more specific details regarding Summer School.

Your student is encouraged to do his or her best on the upcoming End-of-Grade tests. Teachers and students have worked very hard all year long to prepare for them. We feel our students are more than ready to "*rope the test*" and have great success and we look forward to our *EOG Round-up* on Friday, May 22.

In preparation for these important tests, please remember to make sure your child gets a good night's rest, has a nutritious breakfast and arrives by 8:00 to begin testing. Our goal is to begin testing at 8:15. Once the testing session has started, students who are tardy may not disrupt the testing setting and will be required to make-up the test on a different day. Please be reminded of our testing schedule:

- May 27 Grade 5 EOG Science- Brooks' class
- May 28 Grade 5 EOG Science- Beck's class
- May 29 Grade 5 EOG Science- Watson's class
- June 1 Grades 3-5 EOG Science- Ashe's class
- June 3 Grades 3-5 EOG Reading Comprehension
- June 4 Grades 3-5 EOG Mathematics
