Dear Parents of 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students,

We are happy to announce that we will be able to offer a short academic summer school this summer. (Please don't confuse this with attendance summer school as they are two different things.) This academic summer school will be offered...free of charge...to any student who scores below a level 3 on the Reading and/or Math EOG test. At the end of summer school, the students will take a Reading and/or Math EOG (and Science for 5th grade) in hopes that they can achieve a proficient score of a level 3 or higher. The difficult thing about planning this endeavor is that we won't know exactly who needs to attend until regular EOGs are taken and scored. As soon as we receive EOG results in early June, we will begin calling parents and inviting students to summer school. This letter is to let you know that this opportunity is available and to give you some logistical information that you can be thinking about between now and then.

Dates of summer school will be June 15-19 and June 22-26. Summer school instructional times will be morning sessions. Testing days will last longer. More information will be forthcoming after we take EOGs and receive scores. At that point we will immediately be in contact with parents of the students who will need to attend academic summer school and we will be able to give more specific information at that time.

We want all students to do their very best and be successful. Our hope is that this academic summer school will provide our students with that opportunity. Please call if you have questions.
