We are fortunate that Haywood County Schools is providing an opportunity to serve you and your child this summer. Summer School 2015 is a great opportunity for your student to sharpen their reading and math skills and a second chance for him/her to pass the End of Grade test in Reading, Math, or both. Summer School is only for students who are not proficient on End of Grade tests. Your child's teacher will contact you once testing scores are received.

Meadowbrook Summer School will begin Tuesday, June 9<sup>th</sup> and will end Thursday, June 19<sup>th</sup>. The hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Parents may drop students off at 8:50. Students should report directly to their assigned summer school classroom. Students must be picked up promptly at 12:00. Students not picked up by 12:10 will be taken to Meadowbrook Camp.

All students will receive a snack during the summer school program.

The summer school session is 8 to 9 days long depending on your child's individual testing schedule. In an effort to maximize instructional time and provide a classroom climate conducive to learning, we maintain very high expectations for students to follow classroom procedures and display appropriate behavior.

Summer school offers a time of reflection, growth, an opportunity to retest, and preparation for the upcoming year. We look forward to sharing these experiences with your child.
