

SCHOOL BOARD NEWS

The Haywood County Board of Education met for the 2019-2020 Public Budget Hearing and Regular Session on Monday, April 1, 2019 at the Education Center in Clyde, N.C. The 2019-2020 Public Budget Hearing was held at 6:00 p.m. and Regular Session was held at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Francis called the 2019-2020 Public Budget Hearing to order at 6:05 p.m. Jimmy Rogers gave the invocation. Chairman Francis led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Bill Nolte presented the 2019-2020 local budget process as well as four priorities of the 2019-2020 local budget. (*See below*)

- Increase classified supplement from 2% to 4%
- Increase “extra duty pay” for Principals, Assistant Principals and System Level Administrators
- Provide bus driver insurance for individuals working 20 but less than 30 hours
- Provide annual computer replacement funding for schools on an ADM basis
